

School Education FAQs



When are School Education sessions held?

We run sessions on Tuesdays from 10am to 12pm all year round. Bookings are subject to availability.

How many people can attend?

We welcome groups of up to 30 students. We recommend 1 teacher per 15 students.

Where are you located?

We are at 29 Hughes St in Potts Point, a few minutes' walk from both Kings Cross train station and paid parking options.

What will we do on the day?

We have an action packed two hours in store for your students!

Part 1

A presentation and workshop to explore some of the challenges facing many of Wayside's visitors such as homelessness, social isolation and addiction. This session includes group activities to build empathy and knowledge, and concludes with a debrief and opportunity for students to discuss initiatives they may undertake to lend support for those who are disadvantaged in the community.

Part 2

A walking tour of Kings Cross and Woolloomooloo, learning about the history of the area and the many services available to people who need support.

Do you have access for people with restricted mobility?

We have lift access to all floors of the building; the facilitator can choose an alternative walking tour route that does not include stairs; participants can choose from a range of activities during the day according to their abilities.

How much does it cost?

The cost is \$500 plus GST per session. Proceeds go towards our programs and services for people in need. Our team can also visit your school for incursions — please get in touch to discuss this opportunity!
